

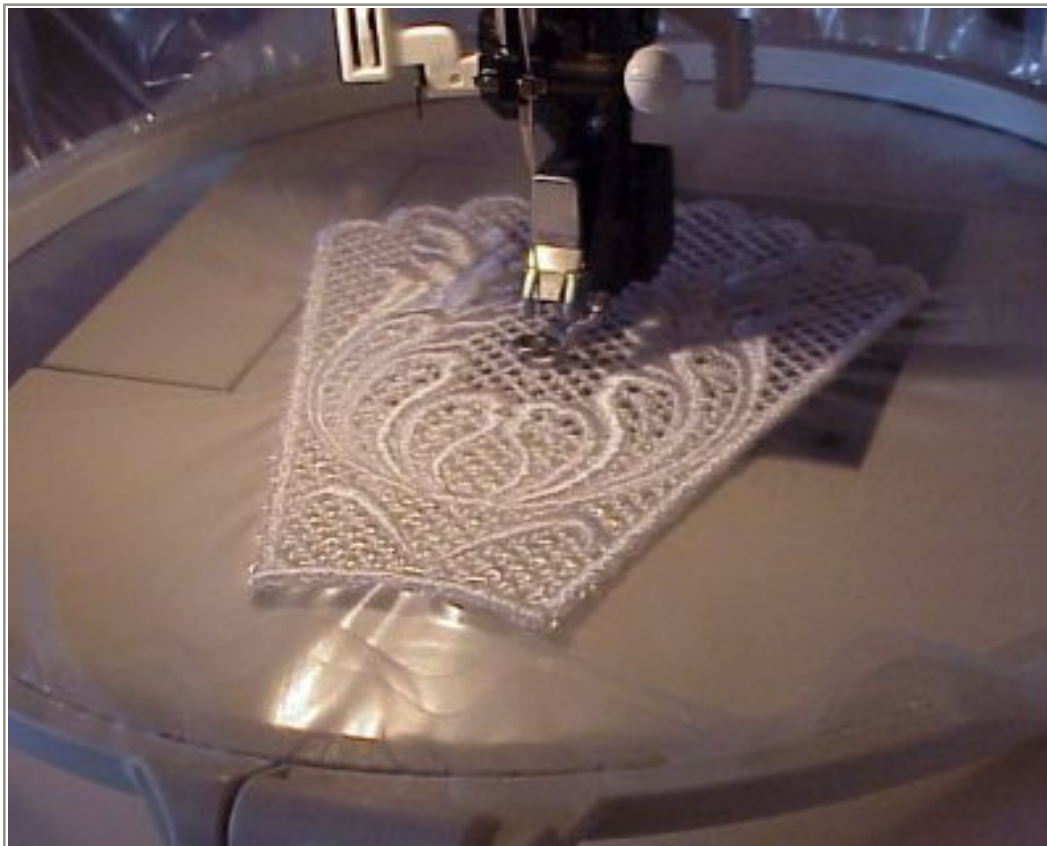
Lace Baskets

**Designs are Stand Alone Lace
Instructions**

There are 5 baskets and 5 bottoms.. for variation

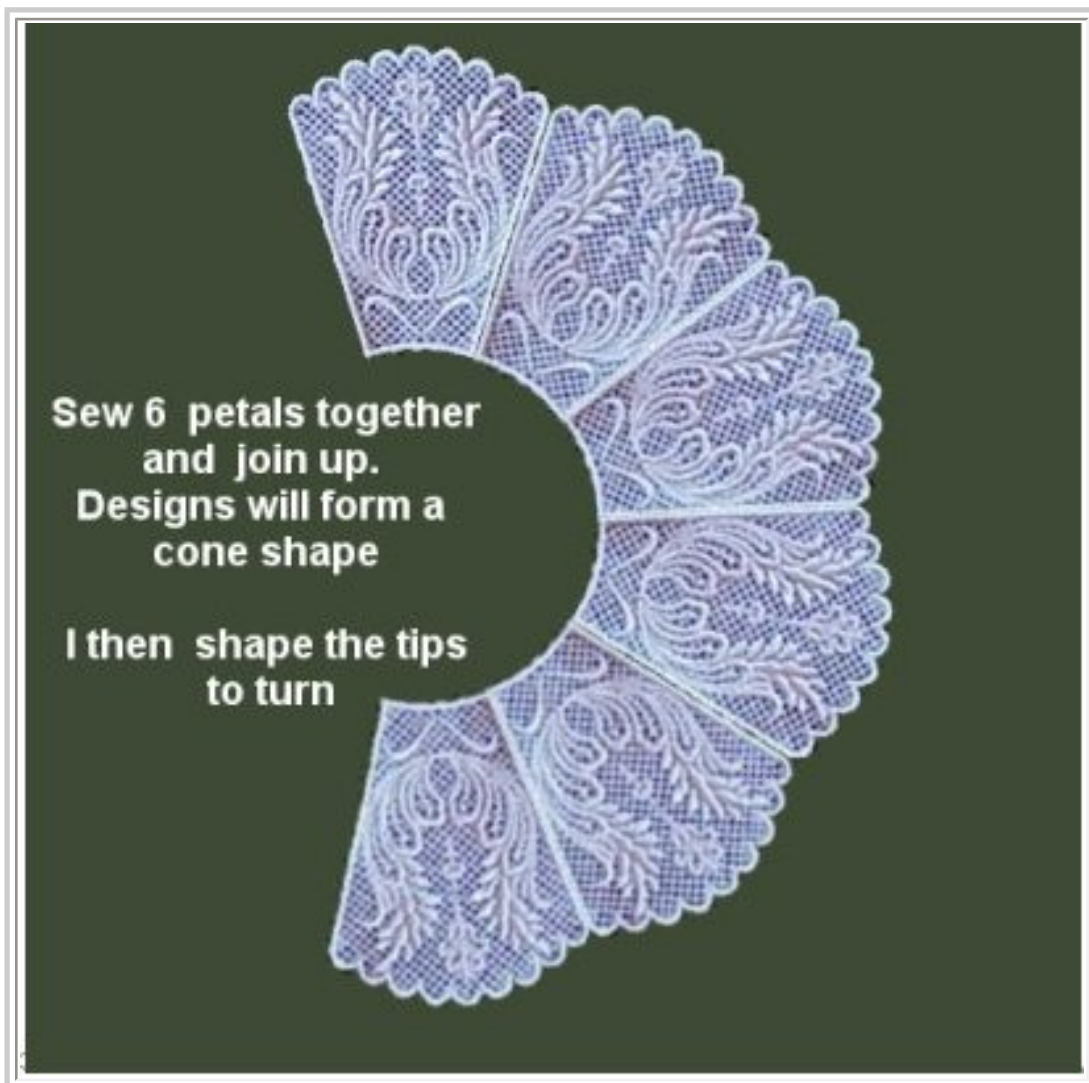
**Supplies Needed are :
2 Layers of badgemaster Soluble stabilizer
I used a number 12 Schmetz Needle
Madeira rayon thread 40 weight . Top and Bobbin**



**Embroidery out 6 Petals
and one center**



I Zig Zagged the 6 petals together, forming the basket top.





Hand Stitching the Base to basket

the basket sits in the base, on inside of the satin stitching ring, so that the scallops sticks out on the bottom...like a saucer, think you can see it on the image , some are gluing it on as they do not want to hand stitch it. but for the hand stitching. set on a glass, go in and out of the hatch/netting then over the first part of the bottom of basket. and keep going till all the way around... each 4 stitches I did a double to secure the stitching



Then I hand stitched the top to the bottom.



**I left the stabilizer in for stiffness
it gives a sparkle to the basket.
but if you choose not to leave it in
make sure you do not dissolve it all out
or you will have to sugar water it or starch it**

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
