


Sew out 2 petals for each flower you want to make the first one I use 2 large each of the others was large and next size then size 3 and 4 and then 4 and 5 no limit to the sizes and shapes Several ways to dry. thos way make a nice flat daisy



this way allows the petals to curl



this way can make a pretty mum when sizes are stacked in each other



I used a round ball to shape the centers for drying



this is the daisy lay out. I used Aleen's to glue together



Sew out the leaves and dry by pinning on styrofoam, allowing edges to curl a bit



Set up your flowers and leave and glue together



Voila have some fun
