

Stain Glass Wall Hanging Pattern

This is Free Standing

Supplies Needed

**I used 2 layers of vilene,
number 12 schmetz universal needle,
40 weight Madeira Rayon thread top
and spun poly in the bobbin. or matching top thread
3 types of fabric.**

I choose a brown and 2 wood type patterns..

there is an alternative way as well.

I am sure many ways.

**One can just sew the blocks together. with out making a shadow box of
them**

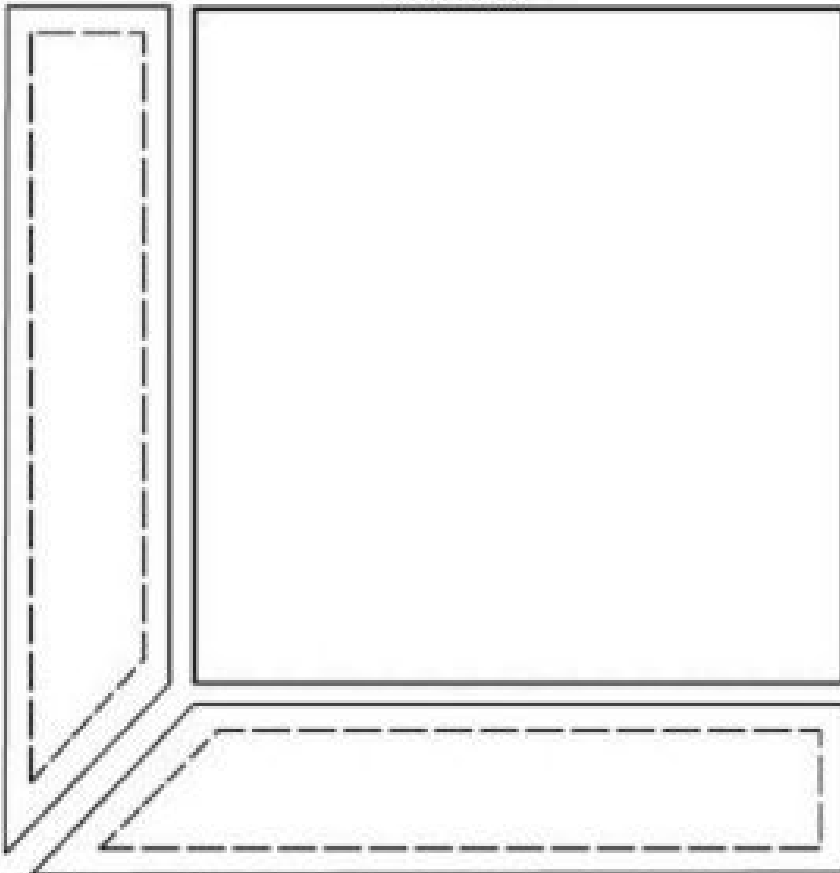


Step one.. Sew out the block on 2 layers of vilene soluble Stabilizer



In this image , I cut 2 strips of fabric, One darker than the other, allowing a 1/4 inch seam allowance then squaring it up to a to fit the Block

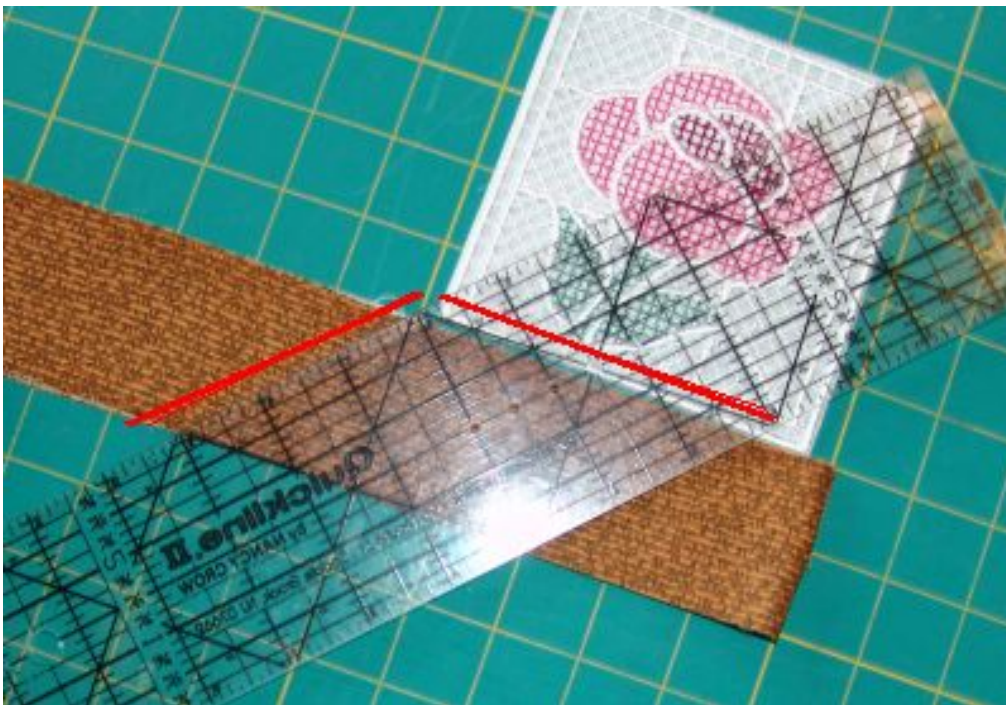

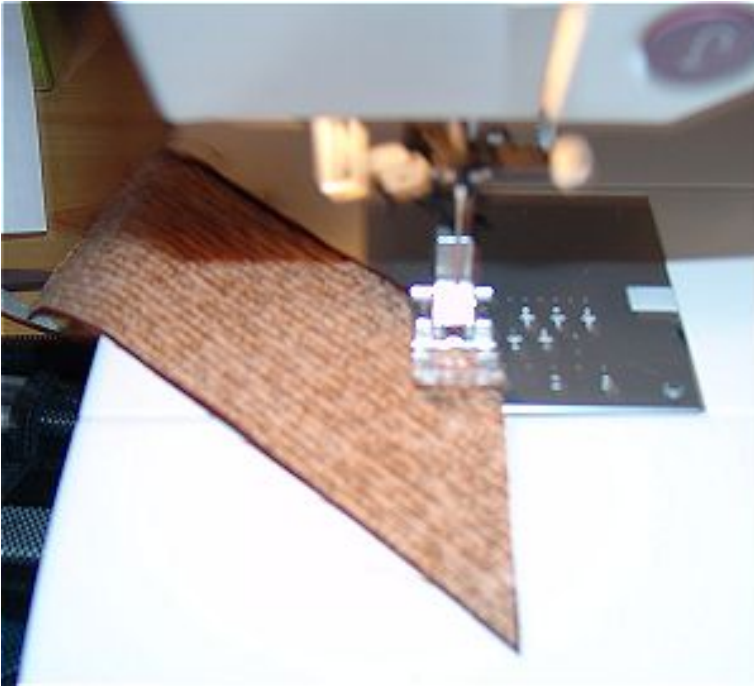
This will be your basic Pattern



to get these pieces ,
I cut 2 inch strips of 2 different colors,
I placed the finished block and allowed 1/2 seam
allowance
One had a pattern the other a brown



Be sure to cut the wedge at a 45
degree angle for a mitered corner



Sew the 2 corners together with a 1/2 inch seam



**Using a zig zag about 2mm ,
Lay the Block on the 2 pieces of fabric
forming the mitered corner and
zig zag the Block to the top of the fabric**



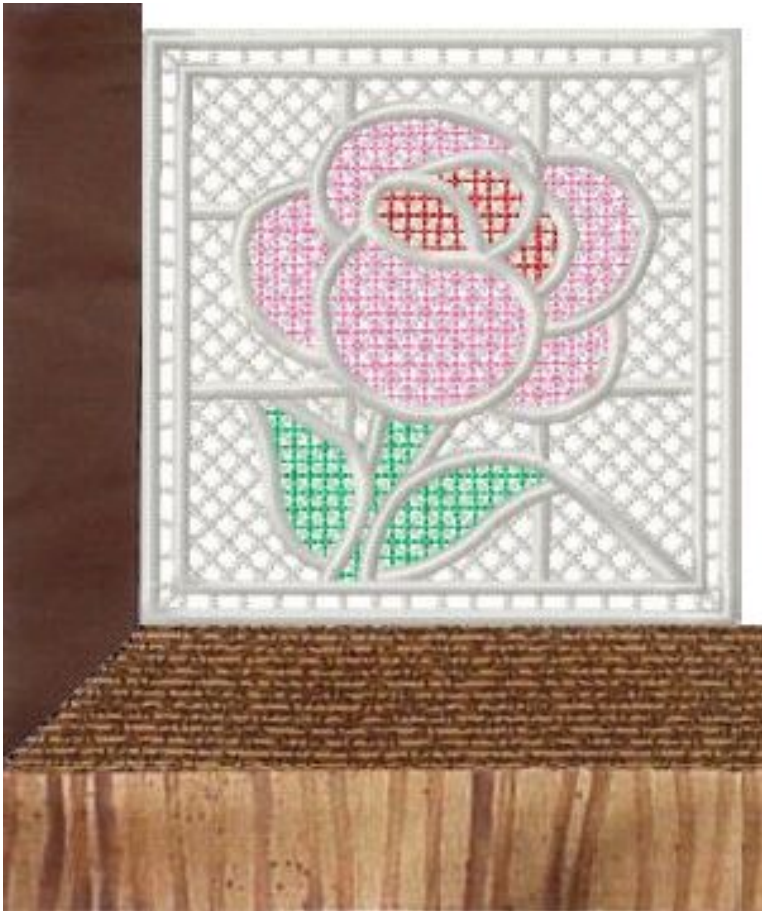
side and bottom



**now sew on a 2 inch strip of the third pattern fabric
this will be the same as the border fabric
It frames off the wood between the window panes
and
the whole window**

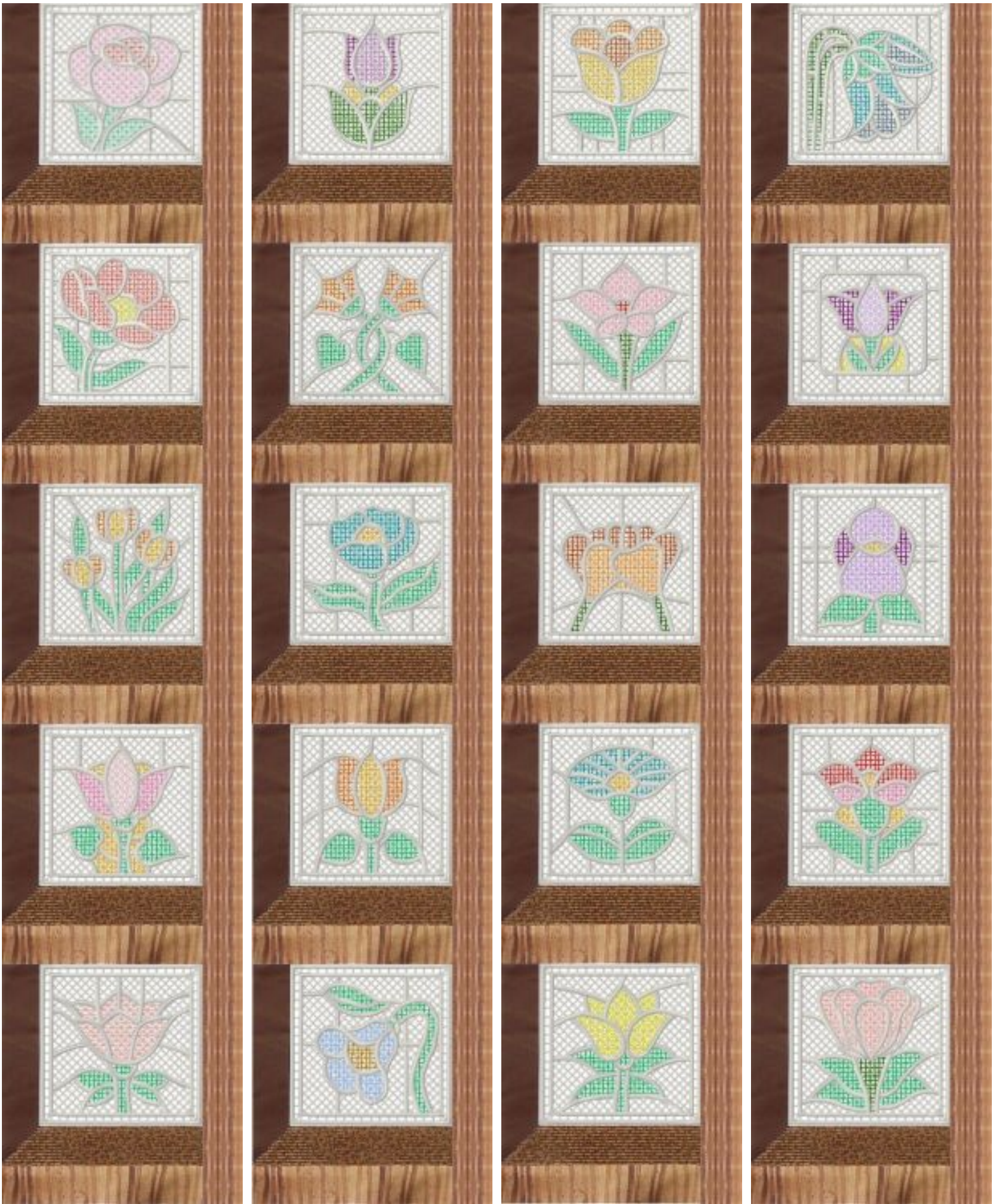


**now time to trim down the pane.
I wait till all are done and then do them together
that way I am sure to get them all even**



Trimmed down pane

You can now start to sew your blocks to gether in stripe



Now the rest is elementary..

you should have 20 like this now.

sew the windows in 4 strips long of 5 windows...

now you will now need 3 strips of fabric the same as the last,

Sew a strip to the right of the first three window strips... now sew the windows together to make your full window.

Cut top/bottom and sides strips for the frame. any size you choose. and finish the wall hanging off...

This the wall hanging sewn together





This is the final wall hanging with the final outside sashing border

**this is one of many ways you can do things with these Squares
Imagine a bed spread, table cloth. Place mats.
with them just sewn together,
Only Limit is with in your own Imagination**
