**Embroidery all blocks  
and trim to all the same size**

**I hooped all three ,  
top, batting and backing**




**Zig Zag the blocks together.  
on the back of the blocks  
I use 5mm wide and about 3 mm length**




**Now sew bias tape or ribbon  
on either side of the Zig Zag,  
I made bias tape from  
the same backing fabric**






I made my sashing for the front




**Now turn over and add your sashing  
I made mine from the same top fabric**






**Do your rows first**




**Now sew your rows together with the zig zag**  
**Careful to match up the corners**





**Repeat the Bias/ribbon on the back**



**turn over and add your sashing.  
to the front of the rows**

**Now bind your quilt  
and then I added lace to the border**
